
LIGHTING:	Mostly T-5 fixtures with some metal halide		
POWER:	Supplied by City of Humboldt; Two 3,000 amp transformers supplying 480/277 volt, 3-phase, 4-wire service. Buss bar distribution.		
WATER:	Supplied by City of Humboldt		
SEWER:	Supplied by City of Humboldt		
NATURAL GAS:	Supplied by Humboldt Utilities; 2" gas line		
FIRE PROTECTION:	100% of the facility is covered by wet sprinkler system		
HEAT:	Supplied from ceiling-suspended gas-fired space heaters		
VENTILATION:	Facility is ventilated via wall-mounted exhaust fans with louvers		
COMPRESSED AIR:	Entire facility is looped for compressed air. Supplied by three Ingersoll-Rand R90 A-145 compressors with dryer.		
OFFICE SPACE:	Approximately 7,500 sq. ft. of modern, one-story, air-conditioned office space featuring 11 private offices, 4 conference rooms, carpet and tile flooring area, acoustical tile ceiling, fluorescent lighting, cafeteria, vending areas, and outdoor picnic and grilling areas.		
RESTROOMS:	Restrooms located in the northeast and southeast areas of the facility as follows:

LOCATION:	U.S. Route 79 and U.S. Route 45W intersect in Humboldt offering 4- lane divided access to Interstate 40 about 13 miles away in Jackson. U.S. Route 55 is about 36 miles away in Dyersburg.
	The nearest airports with regularly scheduled commercial service are Memphis International, about 90 miles away, and Nashville International, about 150 miles away.
